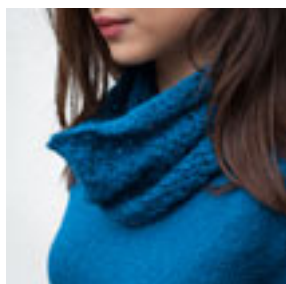

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 31 ½ (34 ½, 39 ¼, 43 ¼, 47 ¼, 51 ¾, 55 ¼, 59 ¾, 62 ¾)" / 80 (87.5, 99.5, 110, 120, 131.5, 140.5, 151.5, 159.5) cm

Length: 26 ¼ (27 ½, 29, 29 ½, 32 ¾, 33 ¾, 35 ½, 35 ½, 36 ¾)" / 66.5 (70, 73.5, 75, 83, 85.5, 90, 90, 93.5) cm

Shown in size 34 ½" / 99.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm positive ease.

Yarn:

13 (14, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24) skeins Kollage Yarns Solace (91 yd / 83 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 70 % Alpaca, 30 % Silk) in #7710 Seaport

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm:

- circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long (40" / 100 cm for larger sizes)
- needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm:

- circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long (40" / 100 cm for larger sizes)
- needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, waste yarn, tapestry needle

Gauge:

19 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

19 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chart pattern using size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

Construction Notes: The body is worked in one piece from the bottom up to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The raglan sleeves are knit separately and sewn in place. The cowl collar and kangaroo pocket are worked in a lace stitch. The lace pattern is given in both chart form and row-by-row instructions.
