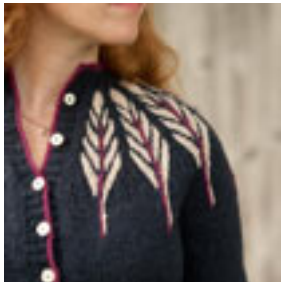

Finished measurements:

Bust: 32 ¼ (35, 38 ¼, 41, 43 ¾, 46 ¼, 49, 53 ¾, 56 ¼)" / 82 (89, 97, 104, 111, 117.5, 124.5, 136.5, 143) cm

Length: 23 ¼ (23 ¾, 24 ½, 25, 25 ¼, 25 ½, 26, 26, 26 ¼)" / 59 (60.5, 62, 63.5, 64, 65, 66, 66, 66.5) cm

Shown in size 35" / 89 cm

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm ease.

Yarn:

Halcyon Yarn Victorian 2-Ply Wool (325 yd / 297 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Wool):

4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7, 8, 9, 10) skeins in #212 Blue (MC)

1 skein in #136 Cream (CC1)

1 skein in #118 Raspberry (CC2)

Needles & Notions:

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long and needles in preferred style for small circumference circular knitting

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long and needles in preferred style for small circumference circular knitting

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Stitch markers, 10 (11, 11, 11, 11, 12, 12, 12, 12) buttons ½" / 13 mm diameter, tapestry needle, waste yarn

Gauge:

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in single color Stockinette stitch using size 3 US / 3.25 mm needle

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over charted colourwork pattern using size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles

Construction Notes: This cardigan is worked in the round from the neck down with a steek at center front. The feather motif on the yoke is worked in a combination of cables and stranded colorwork, and accented with embroidery. There is waist shaping in the body.
