Construction Notes: Good for children and adults. Seamless, saddle shoulder pullover worked in one piece from the top down.

Finished measurements: Chest: 21 (25, 30, 36, 42, 48, 54, 60, 66, 72, 78, 84, 90, 96, 102, 108, 114, 120) cm

Shown in child size 20" / 51.5 cm and adult size 42" / 106.5 cm.

Yarn: 4 (7, 7, 12, 14, 16 skeins) Madeline Yarns Hope (160 yds / 145 m per 2 oz / 57 g skein; 100% undyed organic cotton) or #6500 Organic DK Natural

Needles & Notions: Size US 4 / 3.75 mm 12" / 30 cm, 24" / 60 cm circular needles, set of 4 or 5 double-pointed needles, size US 6 / 3.75 mm smoother hook for provisional cast on, stitch markers, tapestry needles, stitch holders or scrap yarn, smooth woolen weight scrap yarn for provisional cast on

Gauge: 26 sts and 20 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Slip Stitch Rib slightly stretched
