To make the colorwork easier to knit, the cardigan is knit seamlessly in the round and steeked open at the front.

Intended to be worn with 0—2" / 0—5 cm ease.

Yarn: Blue Moon Fiber Arts BFL Sport (661 yds / 604 m per 8 oz / 226 g skein; 100% Blue Face Leicester Wool)
2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3) skeins in Jengu (MC)
1 skein in Star Sapphire (CC)

Actual yardage required: (MC) 875 (965, 1020, 1070, 1125, 1210, 1280, 1360, 1430, 1550, 1620) yds / 800 (882, 933, 978, 1029, 1106, 1170, 1244, 1308, 1417, 1481) m; (CC) 27 (29, 31, 32, 34, 36, 38, 41, 43, 46, 50) yds / 25 (26.5, 28.5, 29.5, 31, 33, 35, 37.5, 39.5, 42, 46) m

Needles & Notions: Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm (or longer for larger sizes)

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles

Stitch markers, smooth waste yarn, tapestry needle, nine buttons $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 19 mm diameter

Gauge: 24 sts and 32 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch in the round

Construction Notes: The cardigan is knit in the round from the bottom up, beginning with an I-Cord Cast On and continuing with additional stitches cast on for the steek at the center front. The sleeves are knit in the round to the underarm and joined with the body for the colorwork yoke, which is worked in the round from a chart. Once the body is complete, the front steek is secured and cut open, and the buttonbands picked up from the front edges.

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
