## Finished measurements:

Bust: 35 (40  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 46, 51  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 56  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 62  $\frac{1}{4}$ )" / 89 (103, 117, 130, 144, 158) cm Shown in size 35" / 103 cm Intended to be worn with about 3–4" / 7.5–10 cm positive ease.

Yarn: 11 (12, 14, 16, 19, 21) balls Valley Yarns Colrain (109 yds / 100 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 50% Merino Wool, 50% Tencel) in Majestic Blue

Needles & Notions: Size 8 US / 5 mm knitting needle Size 6 US / 4 mm knitting needle Size 6 US / 4 mm set of two double-pointed needles Two stitch holders, tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 17 ½ sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chart pattern using larger needles

**Construction Notes:** This wrap-style cardigan is worked in one piece to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The front borders are worked at the same time as the body in an elongated slip stitch pattern. A wide collar frames the face. The cable pattern is given in chart form only. The belt is 3 lengths of I-cord threaded through the cables at the sides of the sweater and tied together at the front.
