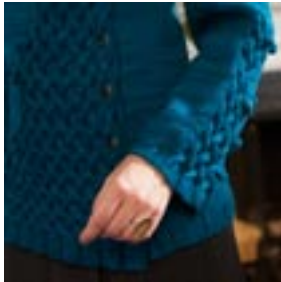

This asymmetrical cardigan features an intricate cable and bobble pattern along the right front, lower sleeves and stand-up collar.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 30 ¾ (33, 35 ½, 37 ¾, 40, 43 ¼,
46 ½, 49 ½, 52 ¾, 56)" / 78 (84, 90, 96, 101.5, 110, 118, 125.5, 134, 142) cm

Shown in size 33" / 84 cm

Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm ease.

Yarn: 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9) skeins Manos del Uruguay Rittenhouse Merino 5-ply (240 yds / 220 m per 3½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Merino Wool) in #543 Juniper

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long or longer

Size 6 US / 4 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles or long circular needle for sleeves

Cable needle, stitch markers, row counter, waste yarn, tapestry needle, 11 (11, 11, 11, 11, 11, 11, 12, 12, 12) buttons ¾" / 20 mm diameter

Gauge: 20 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

Construction Notes: This cardigan is worked in one piece from the bottom up. The sleeves are worked first to the armholes, then set aside while the body is worked. The pieces are then joined, and the yoke is knit with raglan shaping. The cable and bobble pattern on the front, sleeves and collar of the sweater is presented in chart form only. Buttonholes are integrated into the cable pattern along the edge of the right front.

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
