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This round neck cardigan is worked in Brioche stitch. It features bell sleeves and decorative shaping.

Twist Collective

Needles & Notions:

Size 8 US / 5 mm:

- circular needle 24" / 60 cm long
- set of four double-pointed needles

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm:

- circular needle 24" / 60 cm long
- set of four double-pointed needles

Size 2 US / 3.0 mm:

- circular needle 24" / 60 cm long
- set of four double-pointed needles

Size F-5 US / 3.75 mm crochet hook, scrap yarn, stitch markers, tapestry needle, 12 (12, 12, 13, 13, 13) buttons
?" / 15 mm diameter

Gauge: 16 sts and 48 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Brioche stitch using size 4 US / 3.5 mm needle; 24 sts and 30 row = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using size 4 US / 3.5 mm needle

Construction Notes: This cardigan is worked in one piece from the bottom up. It begins with the sleeves, which are worked to the armhole and set aside. The body is worked from the lower edge to the armholes, with waist shaping and buttonholes worked as you go. The sleeves and body are joined and the yoke is worked through the collar, shaped by concentric rings of decorative decreases.

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
