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### Finished measurements:

Bust: 33 ½ (36 ¼, 38 ¾, 41 ¼, 43 ¾, 46 ½, 49, 51 ½, 54, 56 ¾)" / 85 (92, 98.5, 105, 111, 118, 124.5, 131, 137, 144) cm

Length: 20 ½ (21, 22 ¼, 22 ½, 22 ½, 22 ¾, 23, 23 ½, 23 ½, 23 ¾)" / 52 (53.5, 56.5, 57, 57, 58, 58.5, 59.5, 59.5, 60.5) cm

Shown in size 36 ¼" / 92 cm

Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm ease.

**Yarn:** 7 (8, 9, 10, 10, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13) skeins Rowan Yarns by Amy Butler Belle Organic DK (131 yds / 120 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 50 % Organic Wool, 50% Organic Cotton) in #4 Persimmon

### Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm:

- circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long
- set of five double-pointed needles

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Stitch markers, stitch holders, tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Rickrack Lace using size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, slightly stretched; 25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in 2x2 Rib using size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, slightly stretched

**Construction Notes:** The body is worked in one piece from the bottom up. The sleeves are worked separately and sewn in place. The front bands are worked at the same time as the body of the piece. The waist shaping is accomplished by changing needle size. The lace pattern is given in both chart and row-by-row instructions.

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
