Bust: 28 ¼ (31 ¾, 35 ¼, 38 ½, 42, 45 ½, 49, 52 ½, 56, 59 ½, 63)" / 72 (80.5, 89.5, 98, 106.5, 115.5, 124.5, 133.5, 142, 151, 160) cm

Length: 21 ¼ (21 ½, 21 ¾, 22 ¼, 22 ½, 23 ¼, 23 ½, 24, 24 ½, 24 ¾, 24 ¾)" / 54 (54.5, 55, 56.5, 57, 59, 59.5, 61, 62, 63, 63) cm

Intended to be worn with ± 1" / 2.5 cm of ease.

Yarn: 3 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) skeins Madelinetosh Pashmina (360 yds / 329 m per skein; 75% Superwash Merino Wool, 15% Silk, 10% Cashmere) in Posy

Estimated actual yardage required:

742 (834, 925, 1010, 1102, 1194, 1286,

1377, 1469, 1561, 1653) yds / 678 (762, 845, 923, 1007, 1091, 1175, 1259, 1343, 1427, 1511) m

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm needles

Size C US / 2.75 mm crochet hook, three 5/8" / 16 mm buttons, tapestry needle, needle and thread

Gauge: 23 sts and 31 rows = 4" / 10 cm in p4 k1 ribbing after blocking

Construction Notes: This top is worked in pieces and sewn together. The lace pattern worked at the lower edge and sleeves is given in chart form only. Waist shaping is worked through the body. The ribbed button placket at center front is worked together with the body.
