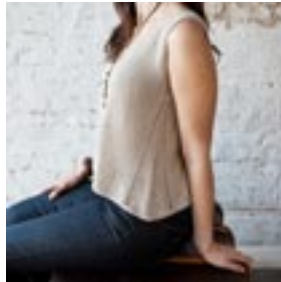


## Twist Collective

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An A-line, scoop neck tank that buttons up the back in cool, crisp linen.

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### Finished measurements:

Bust: 31 (35, 39 ¼, 43 ¼, 47 ½)" / 78.5 (89, 99.5, 110, 120.5) cm

Length: 20 (20 ½, 21, 21, 21 ½)" / 51 (52, 53.5, 53.5, 54.5) cm

**Yarn:** 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) skeins Quince & Company Sparrow (170 yds / 155 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Organic Linen), undyed

### Needles & Notions:

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Stitch markers, removable stitch markers, small amount smooth waste yarn, stitch holders, 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) buttons ½" / 13 mm diameter

**Gauge:** 27 sts and 36 rows = 4" / 10 cm

in Stockinette stitch on larger needles

**Construction Notes:** The tank is worked in one piece from the bottom up. The sides of the tank feature gussets shaped with double decreases and with simple eyelets. The back bands and buttonholes are worked at the same time as the body of the piece.

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
