

Twist Collective

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Cabled edges give a simple cardigan a textural twist.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 31 $\frac{3}{4}$ (35 $\frac{1}{4}$, 39, 42 $\frac{1}{2}$, 46 $\frac{1}{4}$, 49 $\frac{3}{4}$, 53 $\frac{1}{2}$)" / 80.5 (89.5, 99, 108, 117.5, 126.5, 136) cm

Length: 24 (24 $\frac{3}{4}$, 25 $\frac{1}{4}$, 27 $\frac{1}{2}$, 27 $\frac{3}{4}$, 30, 30 $\frac{3}{4}$)" / 61 (62.5, 64, 70, 70.5, 76.5, 78) cm

Shown in size 43 $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 111 cm

Intended to be worn with 6–8" / 15–20.5 cm ease.

Yarn: 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8) skeins Manos del Uruguay Rittenhouse Merino 5-Ply (241 yds / 220 m per 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Merino Wool) in #507 Coffee

Needles & Notions:

Size 8 US / 5 mm needles

Cable needle, stitch markers, tapestry needle

Gauge: 22 sts and 25 rows = 4" / 10 cm in k3, p2 rib, after blocking

Construction Notes: The Celtic-inspired cables are mirrored on the fronts and the sleeves, while the rest of the garment is constructed in an easy knit/purl rib pattern. Since the ribbing does not curl, there is no need for hems and facings, which results in fast knitting and simple construction.

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
