### Finished measurements:

Hand circumference: 7" / 18 cm

Length: 11" / 28 cm

Intended to be worn with no ease.

### Yarn:

Two skeins Universal Yarn Deluxe Worsted (220 yds / 200 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Wool) in #12503 Charcoal Heather

### Needles & Notions:

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm needles in your preferred style for small circumference circular knitting

Cable needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, tapestry needle, four removable stitch markers

### Gauge:

23 sts and 42 rows = 4" / 10 cm in garter stitch

25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

**Construction Notes:** These convertible mittens have flaps that are attached on three sides and fold back to expose the fingertips. Instructions are included to make the thumbs either with or without a flap. The reversible cable pattern is given in both chart and row-by-row instructions. The pattern includes a photo tutorial for the technique used to join the flaps to the mitten hands.
