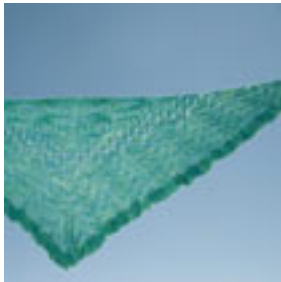
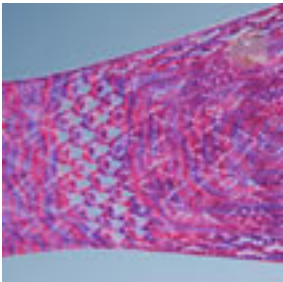

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Stole or shawl, the choice is yours. Either way the results are bound to be beautiful.

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Finished measurements:

Stole: 16" / 40.5 cm wide x 68" / 172.5 cm long

Shawl: 47" / 119.5 cm wide x 21 ½" / 54.5 cm long at center back

Yarn:

Stole: Three skeins Tanis Fiber Arts Purple Label Cashmere Sock (400 yds / 365 m per 4 oz / 115 g skein; 70% Superwash Merino, 20% Cashmere, 10% Nylon) in Jewel

Shawl: One skein Tanis Fiber Arts Silver Label Mulberry Silk (550 yds / 500 m per 4 oz / 115 g skein; 100% Mulberry Silk) in Mallard

Needles & Notions:

Stole: Size 6 US / 4 mm straight needles

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 16" / 40.5 cm long and set of five double-pointed needles

Shawl: Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 29" / 74 cm long

Waste yarn or stitch holder, tapestry needle

Gauge:

Stole: 20 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using size 6 US / 4 mm needles

18 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chart G on size 6 US / 4 mm needles

Shawl: 20 sts and 38 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chart G on size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles

Construction Notes: The pattern includes instructions for both a rectangular stole and a triangular shawl. The lace patterns are given in both charts and row-by-row instructions.
