## Finished measurements:

Women's Bust (closed):

32 ¾ (36 ¾, 41, 44 ¼, 48 ¾, 52 ¾, 57, 60 ¼)" / 83 (93.5, 104, 112.5, 124, 134, 145, 153) cm

Shown in size 36 3/4" / 93.5 cm

Designed to be worn with with  $2\frac{1}{2}-4\frac{1}{2}$ " / 6.5–11.5 cm ease.

Children's Chest (closed):

 $23 \frac{1}{2} (25 \frac{1}{2}, 27 \frac{1}{2}, 29 \frac{1}{2}, 31 \frac{1}{2})$ " / 59.5 (65, 70, 75, 80) cm

Shown in size 23 1/2" / 59.5 cm

Designed to be worn with with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ -3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 6.5-9 cm ease.

## Yarn:

Women's:

3 (3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5) skeins Miss Babs Hand-dyed Yarns & Fibers Yowza Light Worsted (560 yd / 512 m per 8 oz / 225 g skein 100% Superwash Wool) in Aubergine

Childrens's:

4 (4, 5, 5, 6) skeins Miss Babs Hand-dyed Yarns & Fibers Northumbria DK (240 yds / 219.5 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Bluefaced Leicester Superwash Wool) in Verdigris

### **Needles & Notions:**

Women's:

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or greater

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or greater

Three large stitch holders, extra circular needles, or lengths of waste yarn; ten stitch markers; tapestry needle; 8 (8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 10, 10) buttons 1" / 2.5 cm in diameter

### Children's:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or longer

Size 5 US / 3 3/4 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or longer

Three or more large stitch holders, extra circular needles, or lengths of waste yarn; ten stitch markers; tapestry needle; 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) buttons 3/4" / 2 cm in diameter

# Gauge:

Women's:

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on larger needles

#### Children's:

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on larger needles

**Construction Notes:** Hooded, cabled cardigan worked in one piece to the armholes, then divided for the fronts and back. After dividing, the back is worked, including the hood. The fronts are then worked separately to the shoulder shaping and bound off. Sleeves are worked flat and sewn in place. Cable patterns are given in chart form only.

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
