### Finished measurements:

Mitten:

Hand circumference: 7 ¼ (8)" / 18.5 (20.5) cm

Hand length: 6 ¾ (7 ¾)" / 17 (19.5) cm

Total length: 8 ¾ (9 ¾)" / 22 (25) cm

Shown in size 7 ¼" / 18.5 cm

Hat:

Head circumference: 19 ½ (21 ¼)" / 49.5 (54) cm

Length: 7 ¼ (8 ¼)" / 18.5 (21) cm

Shown in size 19 ½" / 49.5 cm

### Yarn:

Quince & Co. Lark (134 yd / 123 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% American Wool):

1 skein each in Leek (Color A), Cypress (Color B), and Parsley (Color C)

1 skein Quince & Co. Finch (221 yd / 202 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% American Wool) in Leek

NOTE: 1 skein of each color will make either the hat or the pair of mittens. For the set, a second skein of colors B and C is required.

### Needles & Notions:

Mittens:

Size 7 ¼" / 18.5 cm:

Size 6 US / 4 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 8" / 20.5 cm:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Hat:

Size 19 ½" / 20.5 cm:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 6 US / 4 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 21 ¼" / 54 cm:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch marker, scrap yarn, tapestry needle

### Gauge:

23 sts and 27 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over Chart pattern using size 6 US / 4 mm needles

21 sts and 24 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over Chart pattern using size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

**Construction Notes:** Worked in the round from the cuff to the top in stranded colorwork. The cuffs have a facing

worked in a lighter weight yarn. Colorwork patterns are given in chart form only.
