



Pure wrap-ture in eyelet and lace.

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Finished measurements:

Length at center back: 27 ½" / 70 cm

Wingspan: 60" / 152.5 cm

Yarn:

1 skein Indigodragonfly Merino Silk Lace (720 yd / 658 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 50% Merino, 50% Silk) in Don't You Have an Elsewhere to Be? (Buffy series)

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size F-5 US / 3.75 mm crochet hook, stitch markers, tapestry needle, T-pins, scrap yarn, blocking wires (optional)

Gauge:

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch, after blocking

Construction Notes: This triangular shawl begins at the center back neck with a narrow eyelet edging, then works down and outward to the crochet loop bind off. Gradually increasing stockinette stitch chevrons are separated by rows of eyelets, and finished with a lace border. The eyelet and border patterns are give in chart form only.

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
