



This pullover features a buttoned neck, with a collar that can be worn open or buttoned up to form a turtleneck. The sweater is knit in the round to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The sleeves are knit separately in the round and sewn into place. The cable pattern is given in both chart form and row-by-row instructions.

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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 33 ¼ (37 ¼, 42 ½, 46 ½, 50 ½, 54 ½, 58 ½)" / 84.5 (94.5, 108, 118, 128.5, 138.5, 148.5) cm

Length: 22 ¼ (23 ¾, 25 ¼, 26, 26 ¾, 27 ½, 28)" / 56.5 (60.5, 64, 66, 68, 70, 71) cm

Intended to be worn with -2 to 2" / -5 to 5 cm ease.

**Yarn:**

8 (9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 16) skeins HiKoo Kenzie (160 yd / 146 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 50% New Zealand Merino, 25% Nylon, 10% Angora, 10% Alpaca, 5% Silk Noils) in #1002 Monument

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or longer

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm or longer

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle, two buttons ¾" / 2 cm diameter

**Gauge:**

20 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using larger needles

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
