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This jacket with a shaped waist and set-in sleeves is worked in one piece to the armholes, then divided for the fronts and back. The sleeves are worked separately in the round and sewn into place. The generous collar can be buttoned up to form a cowl neckline. The stitch patterns are given in both chart form and row-by-row instructions.
