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This body of this cardigan is knit in one piece to the armholes. The sleeves are knit in the round to the armholes, then joined to the body. Work continues on the raglan yoke to the collar. Stitches are picked up along the front edges for the asymmetrical front panels, which are worked in stranded colorwork with a small steak. When the knitting is complete, the steaks are opened and the front panel facings are folded to the wrong side and sewn in place.

Gauge:

19 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

24 sts and 36 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on size 6 US / 4 mm needles

19 sts and 37 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Moss stitch on size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

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
