



This reversible hat is worked in the round from the brim to the crown. It has a band of 2-color brioche rib, which extends into the body of the hat, intersecting with simple stockinette stitch stripes. The pattern includes a photo tutorial for working the brioche rib.

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Finished measurements:

Circumference at brim: 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ (16, 18 $\frac{1}{2}$, 21, 23 $\frac{1}{4}$)" / 35 (40.5, 47, 53.5, 59) cm

Length: 7" / 18 cm

Shown in size 21" / 53.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 2–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm negative ease at the brim.

Yarn:

Universal Yarn Eden Silk (153 yd / 140 m per 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz / 50 g skein; 75% Merino Wool, 25% Silk):

1 skein each in #19 Cream (MC) and #21 Carbon (CC)

Needles & Notions:

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 4 US / 3.5mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, tapestry needle

Gauge:

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in 2-Color Brioche Rib using smaller needles

21 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using smaller needles

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
