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This wedge-shaped tunic is knit in the round from the bottom to the underarms, then divided for front and back.

Stitches are cast on for the sleeves, and back and front are joined along the shoulders and top of the sleeves with an exposed 3-needle bind-off. The simple boat neck is trimmed with a 2-color Vikkel braid.

The Cowl is worked in the round from the bottom up. It features Fair Isle-style stranded colorwork with beads and fur trim. The color pattern is given in chart form only.
