



This pullover is worked in one piece in the round from the top down. The back neck is shaped with short rows and the round yoke features Fair Isle-style stranded colorwork. The color pattern is given in chart form only. The body is shaped through the waist.

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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 32 (36, 40, 42  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 46  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 50  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 56, 62  $\frac{3}{4}$ )" / 81.5 (91.5, 101.5, 108.5, 118.5, 129, 142, 159.5) cm

Length: 24 (24  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 25, 25, 25  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 26, 26)" / 61 (61.5, 62, 63.5, 63.5, 65, 66, 66) cm

Shown in size 40" / 101.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 2–4" / 5–10 cm ease.

**Yarn:**

Blue Moon Fiber Arts Targhee Worsted (616 yd / 503 m per 8  $\frac{3}{4}$  oz / 250 g skein; 100 % Targhee Wool):

1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 2) skein(s) in Jengu (A)

2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skeins in Kate's Blue (B)

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm:

- 16" / 40 cm circular needle
- 24" / 60 cm circular needle
- needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 8 US / 5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Stitch markers, one marker in a unique color or style, waste yarn, tapestry needle

**Gauge:**

18 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in single color Stockinette stitch using smaller needles

22 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over stranded colorwork pattern using larger needles

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
