



This cardigan is worked in separate pieces and sewn together. It features curved lower edges at the fronts, waist shaping, and intricate cable panels at the sides. The set-in sleeves have curved cuffs which echo the shape of the lower front. The collar is worked from stitches picked up along the front edge and shaped with short rows.

Finished measurements:

Bust, buttoned: 31 (34 ½, 38, 42, 45 ½, 49, 52 ½)" / 78.5 (87.5, 96.5, 106.5, 115.5, 124.5, 133.5) cm

Length: 21 ¼ (21 ½, 23, 23 ¼, 24 ¼, 24 ¾, 25 ¼)" / 54 (54.5, 58.5, 59, 61.5, 63, 64) cm

Shown in size 34 ¾" / 88.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 1" / 2.5 cm negative ease to 1–2" / 2.5–5 cm positive ease.

Yarn:

1000 (1100, 1300, 1400, 1500, 1600, 1700) yd / 914 (1006, 1189, 1280, 1377, 1463, 1554) m Catherine Lowe Couture Yarns CLII #7A (82% Merino Wool, 11% Kid Mohair, 7% Silk) in Bronze

Catherine Lowe Couture Yarns are sold in units of 100 yards, not by weight or by the skein. The yarn listed is equivalent to a worsted weight.

Needles & Notions:

Size 8 US / 5 mm needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 60 cm long or longer

Stitch markers, waste yarn, cable needle, four buttons 5/8" / 16 mm diameter, four plain backer buttons with same number of holes as the buttons

Gauge:

18 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm over reverse Stockinette Stitch using larger needles

24-st panel from Charts A or B measures approximately 4" / 10 cm wide
