



This crew-neck raglan cardigan is worked in separate pieces and sewn together. The cable pattern for the body is presented both in charts and row-by-row instructions. The neckband and button bands are worked from stitches picked up along the edges after the raglan seams are sewn.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 33 (36 ½, 39 ½, 43, 46 ½, 48 ¼, 52)" / 84 (92.5, 100.5, 109, 118, 122.5, 132) cm

Length to shoulder: 23 ½ (24 ¼, 24 ¾, 25 ¼, 26, 27 ¼, 28)" / 59.5 (61.5, 63, 64, 66, 69, 71) cm

Shown in size 36 ½" / 92.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5– 7.5 cm ease.

Yarn:

7 (7, 8, 9, 10, 10, 11) skeins SweetGeorgia Yarns Trinity Worsted (200 yd / 183 m per 4 oz / 115 g skein; 70% Superwash Merino, 20% Cashmere, 10% Silk) in Oxblood

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm knitting needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Cable needle, stitch markers, six buttons 1" / 25 mm diameter

Gauge:

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Stockinette stitch

27 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Cable patterns

32-st Chart A panel measures 4 ¼" / 11 cm wide

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
