Finished measurements:

Mitts:

Hand circumference: 6 ¼, (6 ½, 6 ¾, 7 ½, 7 ¾, 8)" / 16 (16.5, 17, 19, 19.5, 20.5) cm

Length: 6 ½ (7, 7, 8 ½, 9, 9 ¼)" / 16.5 (18, 18, 21.5, 23, 23.5) cm

Shown in size 6 ¼" / 16 cm and 7 ¾" / 19.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 0–1" / 0–2.5 cm negative ease.

Cowl:

Circumference: 19 ¾" / 50 cm

Length: 6 ¾" / 17 cm

Yarn:

Indigodragonfly Sad Lester DK (246 yd / 225 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Superwash Blue Faced Leicester Wool):

1 skein in Is the Money Okay? Did They Hurt The Money? (Buffy) (MC)

1 skein Don't Worry; This Capasan-38 Engine Is Like Gold! (Firefly) (CC)

1 skein of each color will make two pairs of mitts or one pair of mitts and one cowl.

Needles & Notions:

Mitts:

For Size 6 ¼" / 16 cm or 7 ½" / 19 cm:

Size 1 US / 2.5 mm

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

For Size 6 ½" / 16.5 cm or 7 ¾" / 19.5 cm:

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm

Size 2 ½ US / 3 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

For Size 6 ¾" / 17 cm or 8" / 20.5 cm:

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Cowl:

Size 2 US / 2.75 mm

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needles, 16" / 40 cm long

Stitch marker, waste yarn, tapestry needle

Gauge:

31 sts and 58 rounds = 4" / 10 cm over Chart pattern using size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles

30 sts and 54 rounds = 4" / 10 cm over Chart pattern using size 2 ½ US / 3 mm needles

29 sts and 52 rounds = 4" / 10 cm over Chart pattern using size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles
