



The cowl is worked in the round. The hat is worked from brim to crown in the round. The twisted stitch pattern is given in chart form only.

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Finished measurements:

Hat:

Circumference at brim: 19 $\frac{3}{4}$ (20 $\frac{3}{4}$, 22)" / 50 (52.5, 56) cm

Length: 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 29 cm

Shown in size 20 $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 52.5 cm

Intended to fit with 1" / 2.5 cm negative ease at brim.

Cowl:

Circumference: 39" / 99 cm

Length: 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 24 cm

Yarn:

5 skeins The Fibre Company Savannah (160 yd / 146 m per 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz / 50 g skein; 50% Wool, 20% Cotton, 15% Linen, 15% Soya) in Persimmon

Note: Two skeins are needed for the hat and three skeins will make the cowl.

Needles & Notions:

Hat:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long and needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Cowl:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Stitch markers, removable stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

Gauge:

28 sts and 40 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Twisted rib pattern using smaller needles after blocking

25 sts and 38 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using larger needles after blocking

32-st Chart A panel measures 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 11 cm wide

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
