This pullover begins with the center front and back panels, which are worked in a slip stitch mosaic pattern from the bottom up. Stitches are picked up along the sides of these panels and worked outward to the side seams, which are joined with a 3-needle bind-off. The set-in sleeves are worked separately and sewn in place. The color pattern is given in chart form only.

**Yarn:**

4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 8, 8) balls Knit One, Crochet Too Elfin Tweed (208 yd / 190 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 60% Merino Wool, 20% Baby Llama, 10% Bamboo, 10% Donegal) in #1682 Loch (MC)

1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 2) ball(s) Knit One, Crochet Too Kettle Tweed (436 yd / 400 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g ball; 60% Merino Wool, 20% Baby Llama, 10% Bamboo, 10% Donegal) in #4523 Seashore (CC)

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 5 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 5 US / 4.5 mm needles

Stitch holders, stitch markers, tapestry needle

**Gauge:**

24 sts and 62 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chart pattern

24 sts and 33 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch with MC
