



This cardigan is knit in one piece from the bottom to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The body has an A-line shape and set-in pockets, with a sinuous twist stitch border. The set-in sleeves are worked separately and sewn in place. The button bands are worked together with the fronts of the cardigan, then extended around the back neck. The

stitch pattern is given in chart form only.

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Finished measurements:

Bust, buttoned: 35 ½ (39 ½, 43 ½, 47 ½, 51 ½)" / 90 (100.5, 110.5, 120.5, 131) cm

Length: 26 (26 ¼, 27, 27 ¼, 27 ¾)" / 66 (66.5, 68.5, 69, 70.5) cm

Shown in size 35 ½" / 90 cm

Intended to be worn with 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

Yarn:

16 (18, 20, 22, 24) skeins O-Wool Classic Worsted (99 yd / 90 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100 % Certified Organic Merino) in # 5200 Plum

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 40" / 100 cm or longer

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Two cable needles, five buttons ¾" / 18 mm diameter, stitch markers, tapestry needle, smooth waste yarn

Gauge:

18 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Twist Stitch Rib and Relief pattern

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
