



This cabled pullover for men or women is worked seamlessly in the round from the bottom up. The women's version has waist shaping; the men's version is tapered slightly at the hip. The sleeves

are worked in the round, then joined to the body. The yoke is worked in the round to the beginning of the neck shaping, then back and forth in rows with seamless saddle shoulders. The collar is worked from stitches picked up along the neckline. The cable pattern is given in chart form only. This design is recommended for experienced knitters.

Women's:

10 (11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16) skeins Brooklyn Tweed Shelter (140 yd / 128 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Wool) in #09 Camper

Men's:

13 (15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20) skeins Brooklyn Tweed Shelter (140 yd / 128 m per 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Wool) in #26 Stormcloud

Needles & Notions:

Women's:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle 32" / 80 cm long

Size 9 US / 5.5 mm circular needle 32" / 80 cm long

Size 9 US / 5.5 needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, waste yarn, tapestry needle, cable needle

Men's:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle 32" / 80 cm long

Size 6 US / 4 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 9 US / 5.5 mm circular needle 32" / 80 cm long

Size 9 US / 5.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, waste yarn, tapestry needle, cable needle

Gauge:

29 sts and 27 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in over chart pattern using larger needle after blocking

23 sts and 36 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in 2 x 2 Slipped Stitch Rib pattern using smaller needle

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
