



The body of this pullover is worked in the round from the lower edge to the armholes, with waist shaping. The $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeves are worked in the round to the armholes, then joined to the body. The yoke is knit in the round, divided to form the unusual diamond shaped openings, then re-joined for the neckline. The yoke patterning is given in chart form only.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 30 ¼ (34 ½, 38 ¼, 42 ½, 46 ¼, 50 ½, 54 ¾)" / 77 (87.5, 97, 108, 117.5, 128.5, 139) cm

Length: 21 ¾ (22, 22 ½, 23, 23 ½, 24, 24 ½)" / 55 (56, 57, 58.5, 59.5, 61, 62) cm

Shown in size 34 ½" / 87.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm ease.

Yarn:

6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) skeins O-Wool Balance (130 yd / 120 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 gm skein; 50% Organic Merino Wool, 50% Organic Cotton) in #4001 Cinnabar

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long or longer

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, cable needle, stitch holders or waste yarn, tapestry needle

Gauge:

19 sts and 27 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

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
