



This skirt is worked in the round from the waist down. The waistband is folded over to enclose the elastic. Knit ribs swirl around the skirt on a reverse Stockinette stitch ground, and end in leaf motifs. The leaf patterns are given in chart form only.

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Finished measurements:

Hip circumference: 35 ¼ (38 ½, 41 ½, 44 ¾, 48, 51 ¼, 54 ½)" / 89.5 (98, 105.5, 113.5, 122, 130, 138.5) cm

Waist circumference: 22 ¼ (25, 27 ¾, 30 ½, 33 ½, 36, 39)" / 56.5 (63.5, 70.5, 77.5, 85, 91.5, 99) cm

Length: 21" / 53.5 cm

Shown in size 38 ½" / 105.5 cm hip

Intended to be worn with up to 1–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm of positive ease at hip.

Yarn:

7 (8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9) skeins Classic Elite Yarns Chesapeake (103 yd / 94 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 50% Organic Cotton, 50% Merino Wool) in #5950 Goldenrod

Needles & Notions:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24–32" / 60–80 cm long, depending on size

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 24–32" / 60–80 cm long, depending on size

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32–40" / 80–100 cm long, depending on size

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 32–40" / 80–100 cm long, depending on size

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, 1 (1, 1, 1, 1 ½, 1 ½, 1 ½) yd elastic 1 ¼" / 3 cm wide, sewing needle and thread to match yarn color, large safety pin or elastic threader

Gauge:

23 stitches and 32 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using smaller needles

20 stitches and 28 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Reverse Stockinette stitch using larger needles

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
