



This long sleeve, pullover tunic is knit in the round from the top down. The twisted rib yoke features an unusual method of constructing the shoulders. There is a twisted rib band at the empire line, which tapers to points at the front. The twisted rib is repeated at the cuff of the sleeves, which are worked in the round, and at the hem, which is longer in the

back and split at the sides. The patterning at waist and cuffs is given in chart form.

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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 32 (35, 39 ¼, 43 ¾, 47 ¼, 51 ¾, 55 ¼)" / 81.5 (89, 99.5, 111, 120, 131.5, 140.5) cm

Length at back: 26 (26 ½, 27, 28, 28 ½, 29, 29 ½)" / 66 (67.5, 68.5, 71, 72.5, 73.5, 75) cm

Shown in size 35" / 89 cm

Intended to be worn with 1–2" / 2.5–5 cm ease.

**Yarn:**

5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 8, 8) skeins Brooklyn Tweed Loft (275 yd / 251 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% American Wool) in #19 Postcard

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circ needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circ needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, stitch holders or waste yarn

**Gauge:**

22 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

24 sts and 34 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Twisted Rib

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
