



The body of this A-line tunic is worked in the round from the bottom up to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The sleeves are worked in the round from stitches picked up at the armholes. The neck edge is finished with an attached i-cord. The lace and twisted stitch patterns are given in chart form only.

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5– 7.5 cm ease.

Yarn:

2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4) skeins The Fibre Company Meadow (545 yd / 496 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 40% Merino Wool, 25% Baby Llama, 20% Silk, 15% Linen) in Pennyroyal

Needles & Notions:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round A

Stitch markers, stitch holders

Gauge:

25 sts and 40 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch before blocking

25 sts and 36 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch after blocking

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
