

A traditional idea with a fresh interpretation, using stranded knitting and pique edge.

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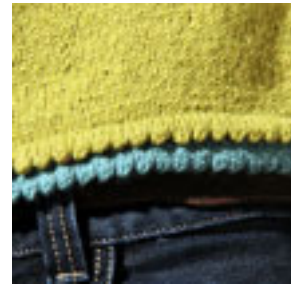
Finished bust measurements: 30 (31, 32, 34, 40, 42, 45, 47, 49, 52, 56/7/9/10, 94, 98, 98.5, 101.5, 106.5, 114.5, 119.5, 124.5, 132, 137) cm. Down in size 37/180 cm.

Yarn: Halcyon Yarn Signature Collection Vindicator 2 Ply Wool (225 yds/207 m per 3.5 oz / 100g skein; 100% Wool) - 3 (1, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 7) skeins in #880 (MC) 1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3) skeins in #129 (CC)

Needles & Notions: Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle 24" / 60 cm or 32" / 80 cm long. Size 4 US / 3.5 mm double pointed needle. Size 3 US / 2.25 mm circular needle 24" / 60 cm or 32" / 80 cm long. Size 3 US / 2.25 mm double pointed needles. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge. Stitch markers, stitch holders, tapestry needles, small amount smooth sewing pins.

Gauge: 24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using larger needles. To save time and to ensure accurate sizing, check gauge.

Construction Notes: The body and sleeves are worked in the round to the armholes, then joined for the circular yoke. Double turned pique forms an inner edge and cuffs. Stranded fard colorwork pattern is given in chart form only.
