Finished bust measurements (Outside): 30" (22), 34", 36", 38", 40", 42", 44", 46", 48", 50" / 77.5 (58, 86, 93, 103, 108, 113, 118, 123, 128.5) cm. Shown in size 34"/87.5 cm. Intended to be worn with 0-1" (-0-2.5 cm negative ease).

Yarn: 2 skeins Blue Moon Fiber Arts 8/1, Sport (90% yarn / 604 m per 8 oz / 225 g skein, 100% Blue Faced Leicester Wool) in Just Right Red. Actual yardage used: 730 (800, 850, 900, 950, 1000, 1050, 1100, 1150, 1200, 1250) yds.

Needles & Notions: Size 4 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long. Size 5 US / 3.75 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles. Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long. Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long. Size 4 US / 3.5 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles. Size 3 US / 2.25 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long. Afghan needle size 7 necessary to obtain correct gauge. Stitch markers, row counter, tapestry needle, stitch holder / stopper pins, 13/16" (18" / 452 mm diameter) and matching thread.

Gauge: 24 sts and 34 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette st on size 4 US / 3.5 mm needles. 22 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Twisted Rib, incidentally established, on size 5 US / 3.75 mm needles. To save time and to ensure accurate sizing, check gauge.

Construction Notes: Knit in one piece to the armbands. Set in sleeves first with stitches picked up at the armbands and work down to the cuffs. Deep ribbing at lower edge and cuffs. Shetland lace pattern rib is not charted - see below instructions only.
