



This shawl is inspired by the sparkling water droplets of a waterfall. It is a perfect showcase for a hand-dyed yarn because the tendency of these yarns to pool unpredictably will actually enhance the overall watery effect.

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**Finished measurements:**

Width after blocking: 24" / 61 cm

Length after blocking: 68" / 173 cm

**Yarn:** 1 skein MacKintosh Yarns Rhiannon Silk Lace (1000 yds / 914 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Silk) in Submerged

**Needles & Notions:** Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 40" / 100 cm long  
Stitch markers (optional), tapestry needle, blocking pins

**Gauge:** 17 sts and 22 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st after blocking

**Construction Notes:** WS rows only purls. Knitted in one piece starting with the bottom edge followed by short rows that give the shawl its unique crescent form. Charts only.

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
