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### Finished measurements:

Bust: 32 ¼ (35 ¼, 38 ¼, 41 ¼, 44 ¼,  
47 ¼, 50 ¼)" / 82 (89.5, 97, 105, 112.5,  
120, 127.5) cm

Length: 23 (24, 24, 24 ½, 24 ¾, 25 ½, 26)" / 58.5 (61, 61, 62, 63, 65, 66) cm

Shown in size 35 ¼ / 89.5 cm

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm ease.

**Yarn:** Valley Yarns Sheffield (120 yds / 109 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 70% Merino Wool, 15% Silk, 15% Angora):  
10 (11, 12, 14, 14, 15, 16) balls in #26 Red (MC)  
1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 2, 2) ball(s) in #25 Natural (A)  
1 ball each in #14 Brick Red (B) and #24 Purple (C)

### Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circ needle, 16" /

40 cm long

Size G–6 US / 4 mm crochet hook, two stitch holders

**Gauge:** 24 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Rib patt  
The 46 rows of Slip Stitch patt meas 4½" / 11.5 cm long

**Construction Notes:** This sweater is knit in pieces and sewn together. The body is worked in a wide ribbing, interrupted by a broad band of slip stitch patterning at the yoke. The slip stitch pattern is presented both in a chart and in row-by-row instructions. The set-in sleeves are worked separately and sewn into place. Stitches are picked up along the neckline for the hood, which is shaped with decreases in the back and joined at the top with a 3-needle bind off. Decorative ties are attached at the front of the hood.

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
