Finished measurements:

Bust: 30 ¼ (33, 36, 39, 42 ¼, 45, 48, 51, 54 ¼)" / 77 (84, 91.5, 99, 107.5, 114.5, 122, 129.5, 138) cm
Length: 23 (23 ½, 24, 24 ½, 24 ¾, 25, 25 ¼, 25 ¾, 26)" / 58.5 (59.5, 61, 62, 63, 63.5, 64, 65.5, 66) cm

Versions 1 and 2 shown in size 36" / 91.5 cm
Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm ease.

Yarn:

Version 1: 9 (10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18) skeins Classic Elite Yarns Magnolia (120 yd / 110 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 70% Merino, 30% Silk) in #5424 Berry

Version 2: 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 7) skeins Black Trillium Fibres Sublime (260 yd / 238 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Merino) in Silverlight

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 6 US / 4 mm set of 4 double-pointed

needles or circular needle 32" / 80 cm long or longer for magic loop

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Safety pin, stitch markers, two split ring markers, stitch holders, tapestry needle

Gauge:

22 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette st with larger needle

9-st Intertwined cable measures 1 ¼" / 3 cm wide

Construction Notes: This sweater is knit in the round from the bottom up. The body has a shaped waist and asymmetrically placed cables. The number of cables varies depending on the size made. The cable pattern is presented in chart form only. The body is worked in the round to the armholes, then divided for back and front and continued to the shoulders. The sleeves are worked in the round from stitches picked up around the armholes. The neckband is worked from stitches picked up along the neck edge.
