



This raglan pullover features a funnel neck, long sleeves with pointed cuffs, and an intricately cabled lace panel at center front and back and down each sleeve.

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Finished measurements:

Bust measurements: 35 ¼ (38 ¾, 41 ½, 44 ¼, 47 ¾, 50 ½, 53, 56 ½)" / 89.5 (98.75, 105.5, 112.25, 121.25, 128, 134.75, 143.75) cm

Shown in size 35 ¼" / 89.5 cm

Yarn: 14 (15, 16, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21) skeins Kollage Yarns Fantastic (92 yds / 84 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Merino Wool) in Dark Orchid

Needles & Notions:

Size 8 US / 5 mm circular needles, 16, 24 and 32" / 40, 60 and 80 cm long and set of 4 double-pointed needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needles, 16 and 32" / 40 and 80 cm long and set of 4 double-pointed needles

Stitch markers, cable needle

Gauge: 18 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm
in Stockinette stitch using larger needles

Cable panel (27 sts) measures 4 ¾" /
12 cm wide.

Construction Notes: This sweater is worked in one piece in the round from the the top down. It begins with the collar, and increases along the raglan lines shape the yoke. At armhole level, the sleeve stitches are set aside and the body is continued, with waist shaping, to the narrow rolled lower edge. The sleeves are worked from the reserved stitches down to the pointed cuffs, which are shaped with short rows integrated into the cable pattern. The cable and lace pattern is presented in chart form only.

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
