



This sleek tunic features set-in sleeves, inset front pockets, subtle waist shaping and gentle tucks at the round neck and cuffs.

Yarn: 3 (3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4) skeins Blue Moon Fiber Arts Woobu (620 yds / 566 m per 8 oz / 226 g skein; 60% Merino, 40% Bambu) in Raspberry Moose

Actual yardage required: 1400 (1500, 1600, 1700, 1800, 1900, 2050, 2150, 2300) yds / 1272 (1364, 1455, 1545, 1636, 1727, 1864, 1955, 2091) m

Needles & Notions:

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm:

- circular needle 32" / 80 cm long
- circular needle 16" / 40 cm long
- set of 5 double-pointed needles

Size 4 US / 3.75 mm:

- circular needle 32" / 80 cm long
- circular needle 16" / 40 cm long
- set of 5 double-pointed needles

Cable needle, stitch markers, row counter, tapestry needle, stitch holders or scrap yarn

Gauge: 24 sts and 33 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on size 5 US / 3.75mm needles

Construction Notes: The tunic is worked in Stockinette stitch in the round from the bottom up. The body begins with a turned hem, then is worked to the armholes, with the pockets knit along the way, divided for front and back and continued to the shoulders. The sleeves are worked in the round from stitches picked up around the armholes down to the bell cuffs with tucks.

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
