Intended to be worn with 2–4" / 2.5–5cm positive ease.

Yarn:

Halcyon Yarn Victorian 2-Ply Wool (325 yds / 297 m per 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz / 99 g skein; 100% Wool):

4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9, 10) skeins in #103 Cream (MC)

1 skein in #114 Rust (CC1)

1 skein in #135 Taupe (CC2)

Needles & Notions:

Size 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 3 mm

Size 3 US / 3.25

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm

In each size: Circular needle 32" / 80 cm long and preferred needles for small circumference knitting in the rnd.

Stitch markers, nine buttons 5/8" / 16 mm diameter, tapestry needle, waste yarn or stitch holders

Gauge:

28 sts and 36 rows = 4" / 10 cm in single color St st using size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles

28 sts and 36 rows = 4" / 10 cm in over Chart pattern in St st using size 5 US / 3.75 mm needles

Construction Notes: This cardigan is worked in the round from the bottom up. Sleeves are joined to the body at the underarm, and the yoke is worked in the round. There is a steek at center front, which is cut and finished with button bands. The design features bands of stranded colorwork at the hip and the yoke, which is presented in chart form only, framed with twisted braids.

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
