### Yarn:

Briggs & Little Softspun (240 yds / 219 m per 4 oz / 113 g skein; 100% Pure Wool):

4 (4, 4, 5, 4, 6, 6, 7, 8) skeins in #04 Cream (MC)

1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) skein in #168 Red (CC1)

1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) skein in #41 Navy Blue (CC2)

### Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Size 8 US / 5 mm double-pointed needle

Two stitch markers, tapestry needle

### Gauge:

17 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette st using smaller needles

17 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Slip Stitch Pattern using smaller needles

Knitting a gauge swatch in the round is strongly recommended.

**Construction Notes:** This cardigan is worked in pieces and sewn together. The back is worked from the bottom up. The fronts are worked from the sides toward the center front. The 3-color slip stitch pattern, which is presented in chart form only, is used on the fronts and the sleeve cuffs. Edges are finished with applied i-cord.

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
